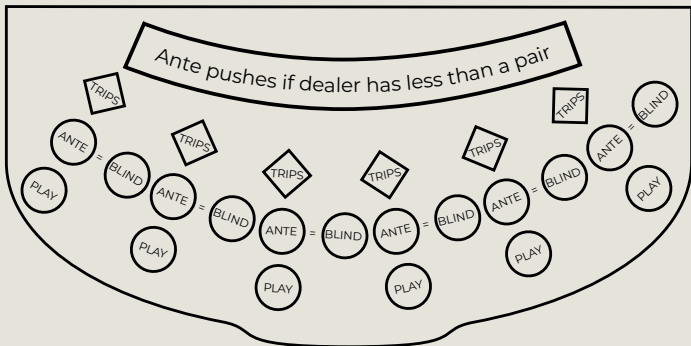

Quick reference guide for excitement at the poker table

Playing Ultimate Texas Hold'em is “awesome” (as they say in Texas)! C'mon now: Get your spurs on, and gallop into the excitement of our casino. Questions? Talk to us! We want to make your visit to our casino one to remember! And who knows, maybe “ya'll” will hit your lucky streaks today!

Table

- Ultimate Texas Hold'em is played at a table with 1 to 7 players (depending on the playing field size).
- For each hand, equal bets are placed in the “Ante” and “Blind” circles.
- The game is played with face-down community cards.
- The game is played against the bank.
- An optional “Trips” bonus bet gives players additional chances to win.



Rules of the game

- The object of the game is to get a better hand than the dealer – in other words, to form the best five-card hand from seven cards (two of your own and five community cards).

How to play

- Before the game: Each player places equal bets in the "Ante" and "Blind" circles; you can also place a "Trips" bet. You will then be dealt two face-down cards that only you are allowed to see.
- After you have looked at your cards, you decide whether to check (not bet on "Play") and wait, or whether to place a bet that is three to four times the "Ante" on "Play".
- The dealer then turns over the first three community cards.
- If the player has used his or her first opportunity to check: Wait or bet twice the amount in the "Ante" circle on "Play".
- Next, the dealer turns over the last two community cards.
- If the player has checked: The basic "Ante" bet can now be placed on "Play".
- If the player does not want to play: The "Ante", the "Blind" and the "Trips" bets (if placed) are collected.
- Players: The dealer reveals his or her two cards and forms a hand with the community cards.
- If the player has the better hand: "Play" and "Ante" are paid out 1 to 1.
- If the dealer has the better hand: The bank wins the bets on "Ante", "Play" and "Blind".
- Dealer qualification: He or she needs one pair to qualify. Otherwise, the "Ante" is returned to the players. All other bets are handled as follows:
 - Tie: The bets on "Ante", "Play" and "Blind" stay.
 - "Blind" is paid out: If the player wins with at least a Straight.
 - "Blind" stays, but is not paid out: If the player wins with less than a Straight.
 - "Trips" bet: The player wins the bet with a hand of Three-of-a-Kind or better.



Royal Flush

Ace, king, queen, jack, and 10
of the same suit



Straight Flush

5 consecutive cards of the same suit



Poker (Four of a Kind oder Vierling)

4 cards of the same value



Full House

Three of a Kind and a pair



Flush

5 cards of the same suit



Straight (Strasse)

5 consecutive cards of various suits



Three of a Kind (Drilling)

3 cards of the same value



Two Pairs (zwei Paare)

2 sets of pairs



One Pair (ein Paar)

2 cards of the same value



High Card

The highest card wins the hand if there are no
other winning combinations.

Progressive Jackpot

Side game for Ultimate Texas Hold'em

A CHF 5 bet must be placed on the designated "coin spot" before any cards are dealt. This must be accompanied by a bet on the base game, «Ante» or «Blind». It is not possible to play progressive jackpot on its own. Winnings are paid out for full house card combinations or higher.



Full House
CHF 50 payout



Poker
CHF 500 payout



Straight Flush
CHF 1,500 payout



Community Royal Flush
(with five board cards and no personal cards)
CHF 5,000 payout



Royal Flush
(with at least one personal card)
100% payout according to jackpot display

Additional Information

Want to place bets at the table? Use your chips! Our staff are happy to exchange your cash for chips at the table. Foreign currencies can also be exchanged for chips at the cage at any time.
