What is Ultimate Texas Hold'em?

Ultimate Texas Hold'em is an exciting variation of classic poker. In this game, you don't play against other guests – you play against the dealer, giving you a clear overview of your chances at all times.

Experience the thrill of poker combined with the simplicity of a table game.

The Aim of Ultimate Texas Hold'em

The aim of the game is to have a better poker hand than the dealer. You create your best possible **five-card poker hand** using **your two personal cards and the five community cards**.

Whoever has the stronger hand wins!

The Table

Ultimate Texas Hold'em is played at a table with one to seven players, depending on the size of the layout.

For each hand, the **Ante and Blind** bets must be placed at the same amount. In addition, you may place optional side bets on **Trips** and/or the **Progressive Jackpot**.

How to Place Your Bets?

Ultimate Texas Hold'em is played with value chips. The dealer opens the betting round with the words: **“Place your bets, please.”**

You may place bets until the dealer signals the end of the betting phase with a sweeping hand gesture across the table or announces:
“No more bets.”

After this point, your bet is final – and the cards are dealt.

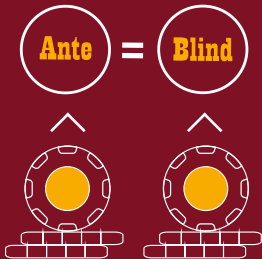
The **Ante and Blind bets are mandatory. Trips and the Progressive Jackpot are optional side bets** that offer attractive winning opportunities.

Game Sequence

1. Placing Your Bets

You place equal bets on the
Ante and Blind.

You may also choose to place
the optional side bets **Trips**
and/or **Progressive Jackpot.**



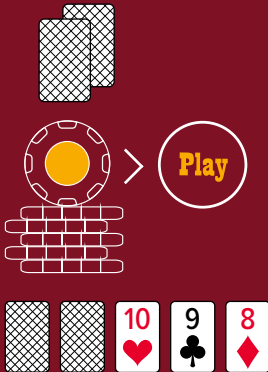
2. Cards and Decisions

You receive **two face-down cards**.

You can then either **check (wait)** or **place a Play bet of up to three or four times your Ante bet**.

Once the first three community cards have been revealed, you can either check or place a Play bet of up to twice the Ante bet.

Once the final two cards have been revealed, you can either fold or place a Play bet equal to the Ante bet.



3. Showdown

The dealer reveals their cards and only qualifies with a hand of one pair or higher.

If the dealer does not qualify, the Ante bet is returned to the players. Whoever holds the better hand wins!

Play & Ante: Pay 1:1

Blind: Pays on a Straight or better

Tie: All bets remain in place

With the optional **Trips bet**, you can win **additional payouts** regardless of the result of the main game. You win if your final poker hand contains **at least Three of a Kind**.

Progressive Jackpot

With a **CHF 5.– bet**, you automatically participate in the **Progressive Jackpot**. You receive a payout if you achieve a **Full House or better**. **With a Royal Flush, you win 100 % of the displayed jackpot amount.** If several players win at the same time, the jackpot is shared equally among them. The jackpot is linked across all casinos in the Swiss Casinos Group.

Envy Bonus: If a guest hits a Royal Flush, all other guests who have placed a progressive bet in that round will receive an Envy Bonus of CHF 500.–.

Playing with the Swiss Casinos Member Club Card

With your Swiss Casinos Member Club Card, you automatically collect reward points and level points. Reward points can be redeemed in the rewards shop, while level points increase your status within the Member Club. For each game you play, you always receive the same number of reward points and level points.



Glossary

- **Ante:** Mandatory bet placed before the start of a round.
- **Blind:** Second mandatory bet, which must be equal in value to the Ante.
- **Play:** The bet you place to continue playing; you may increase it depending on the game situation.
- **Hole Cards:** Your two personal cards, which only you are allowed to see.
- **Check:** The player's decision to make no additional Play bet during a betting phase (alternatively signalled by tapping the table with a finger).
